Fee Payment Information

Fees are paid fortnightly, two (2) weeks in advance. A full session fee is charged regardless of the number of hours your child attends. Parents/Guardians are required to pay for the full term of operation while their child is enrolled at the service. School holiday periods will not be charged as After School Care times.

Account statements are issued by email fortnightly. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to register with the Department of Human Services (mygov.com.au) for Child Care entitlements. You must forward the following information for Child Care Subsidy (CCS) to be processed by the centre: Child Care Reference Number (CRN), Child DOB, Parent/Guardian CRN, and Parent/Guardian DOB.

FEES ARE REQUIRED TO BE PAID using Debit Success, this is the only method of payment accepted. Direct debit payments can be set up from your credit card or bank account. Any queries in relation to billing can be addressed by calling Administration on (02) 9526 7000.

Daily Information

Curriculum Facts

Our program follows the My Time Our Place Framework. This curriculum focuses on collaboration between children and educators to provide play and leisure opportunities that are meaningful to children and support their wellbeing, learning and development. Our environment pays close attention to the needs and interests of individual children. An emphasis is put on children having choice and control over their learning as they collaborate with friends and educators to extend their life skills and develop dispositions towards community participation.

Educators

The Nominated Supervisor is responsible for the overall implementation of the program at The Scots College OOSH. The Nominated Supervisor is also the first point of contact for parents/guardians to communicate with regarding the program and matters affecting their child/ren.

Educators are employed using a minimum ratio of 1:15 and all educators hold a Working with Children's Check. At least one educator on the premises will hold a current first aid certificate and child protection qualification. Our educators are all experienced in the provision of care and recreation activities for children. Educators role model positive social interactions and are energetic, empathetic, caring, fun and reliable. They challenge children's knowledge through scaffolding learning and creating a program which supports children's interest.
